

- Thanks to all who planned and promoted this survey and those who entered data. Their help was invaluable.


Respondents by Sex Compared to Hillsdale 2011 Population Estimates






Age Breakdown of Respondents




• 75% of our survey respondents were female compared to 50% in the general population.

 32% of our survey respondents were age 65 or over, compared to 16% in the general population.


Respondents by Race and Ethnic Origin Compared to the 2010 County Census






Source of Health Insurance




Medical Insurance by Type




Respondents on Medicare with Supplemental Plans




Respondents with Prescription or Dental Insurance






Jobless Rate Hillsdale County Compared to Michigan


Why are 78 Respondents Living with Others?




Number of Children at Home




Graduation Rates of Hillsdale Residents Compared to Michigan, 2010

Where Respondents Go for Medical Treatment




Respondents with Physicians




Respondents with Personal Physician






Some Other Chronic Conditions




Respondents who Smoke


Respondents Who Drink Alcohol




Respondents Who Reported Binge Drinking (5 or more drinks) in the Past Month on the BRFS, 2008-2010 Average




How Respondents Consider their Weight






Weight Reported by Branch-Hillsdale-St. Joseph Residents, Michigan BRFS, 2008-2010




Mental Health Issues in the Past Year






Medical Services Used in Past Year




Some Medical Services Respondents Used in the Past Year



Female Respondents and Medical Services Used




Male Respondents and Medical Services Used




Respondents Who Were Hospitalized in Past Year




Respondents Who Were Hospitalized by Number of Occasions

Respondents who Reported Cost Prevented Them from Seeking Medical Services in the Past Year, MI BRFS 2008-2010 Average






Respondents Who Said They Were Very Concerned with Various Issues




Respondents Who Said They Were Not Concerned with Various Issues




Respondents Concerned about Environmental Issues




Respondents Concerned about Safety Issues




