

## Having trouble paying your hospital bill? You could be eligible for Financial Assistance

Hillsdale Hospital is committed to minimizing the financial barriers to health care that exist for certain members of our community, in particular those not adequately covered by health insurance or governmental payment programs such as Medicare or Medicaid. As such, financial aid to assist low income, uninsured or underinsured individuals with their hospital claims is available to all who qualify in accordance with Hillsdale Hospital's Financial Assistance Policy.

## Do you qualify for Financial Assistance?

Emergency and medically necessary hospital services provided by Hillsdale Hospital and our employed physicians are eligible for financial assistance consideration. If you are unsure whether the services you received are eligible, please contact our Financial Counselor at 517-437-5222.

Discounted care for eligible services, within the last 270 days, may be provided to those whose family income is 300% or below the Federal Poverty Guidelines.
